



 Foster Care: Generic term that refers to all types of 24-hour licensed or certified out-ofhome care.



Types of Foster Care

- IV-E: Also known as
 Title 13 Foster Care,
 maintenance is paid at
 the TANF match rate for
 eligible children in
 foster care or subsidized
 adoption.
- 100% Federal dollars
- Non IV-E: Foster Care Category classified by State CSS as a Non-Public Assistance case, aka Title XX Foster Care. Application for services is required.
- State and County Funds

IV-D Referral

- What Option is your county?
- Regardless of what option your county is, IV-E child support cases are mandatory referrals to your IV-D office.

Referral Criteria Exclusions

- Not in continuous placement for 31 days
- The child's parent is non-cooperative w/dept staff in providing information on the absent parent
- The absent parent is unknown
- The best interest of the child will not be served
- Deprivation status under IV-E eligibility is "unemployment of the principle wage earner"
- Not in a reimbursable (by IV-D) placement



- Reimbursable to Child Welfare does not mean the same thing to Child Support.
- ACSES reads certain criteria from TRAILS to determine if the child should display as active on ACSES.

- Both Funding and Service must be open.
- Adoption Status must be blank
- Appropriate Participation Type
- Pay Code must be Y
- Look for single asterisk for IV-E, double asterisk for Non-IV-e

 Child does not exist in TRAILS with that State ID,

Or

 Child exists in TRAILS with that State ID, but has multiple client id's

Review each referral:

- One Placing Parent/Fee case and one Child Support case, OR,
- Two Placing Parent/Fee Cases (intact family) OR,
- Two Child Support Cases (both parents absent from the home)



Fee Cases

- Established against the parent(s) the child(ren) were living with at the time of placement (PLACING PARENT)
- Foster Care Fee Order/terminates when placement ends
- IV-E or Non IV-E
- ACSES requires the use of the 25 suffix
- CP defaults to FOSTER CARE FEE-Placing Parent is the NCP.

• Fee orders <u>CANNOT</u> be established or modified to include child support and/or TANF debt. The system does not support this and, should it occur, the ledger must be handled manually.



Child Support Cases

- Established against the parent absent from the home, Placing Parent would be the CP on this case.
- Existing Child Support orders established/enforced
- IV-E or Non IV-E
- County designated suffix

 Child lives with aunt and is placed in Foster Care. The referral meets all of the criteria.
 What kinds of cases do I create on ACSES?
 Who is the CP?

Scenario 2

 Child(ren) are placed from Mom & Dad's home, neither parent is absent from the home. What kinds of cases do I create on ACSES? Who is the CP?

 Child is living with Mom and is placed from her home. What kinds of cases do I create on ACSES? Who are the CP's?

IV-E on ACSES

- IV-D case cl-st is A/C, child class is 'E'
- Unreimbursed maintenance Payment (UMP) is the amount of IV-E maintenance payments not reimbursed by CSS collections or other recoveries
- UMP is tracked on ACSES (FCFINHIS)
- Fee or Child Support

NON IV-E on ACSES

- IV-D case cl-st can be A/C, B/C or N/C with the active Non IV-E child class of 'F'
- Cost of care is tracked by the business office, NOT ACSES
- Fee or Child Support

 The IV-E or Non IV-E flags will display in CASEMAIN, Opt A, screen 1 in the county where the child is in active placement.



Case Class/Status	Child Class
A/C	At least one child must be "A" or "E". If multiple children exist on the case, you may also have "F", "N", "Z" or "X".
B/C	F, N, Z, X (you can not have a child with an "A" or "E" class)
N/C	F, N, Z, X (you can not have a child with an "A" or "E" class)

 Existing child support case in our county with 3 children. Current Case cl/st is A/C due to the receipt of TANF benefits. One of the children goes into placement. What do you do? One of the kids goes into Non-IVE placement. What do you do?

 Existing child support /fee case in your county with one remaining child. The existing case clst is N/C. Child goes into IV-E Placement. What do you do?

Scenario 3

• Existing child support/fee case in your county. The child goes into active placement in another county. What should happen?

Placement Terminates

- The Fee Case must be changed to an arrears only status (Current Fee ceases when placement terminates regardless of IVE/NIVE status)
- Continued Services apply to IVE child support cases, and status should remain current (may need to change the child class or case cl-st)

Placement Terminates, continued

- CP must apply for services on a Non IV-E
 Foster care case when child leaves placement.
 If this does not occur, case cl-st must change to pass-through.
- If cases existed prior to child going into Non IV-E placement, continued services would apply and the CP would not need to re-apply for services.


- IV-E Maintenance posting exceptions report

- Explains why IV-E Maintenance was not posted




Examples
