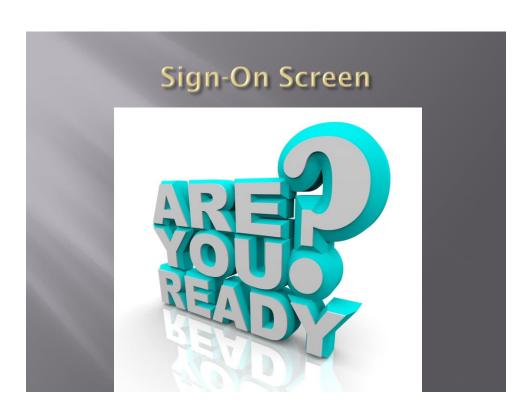


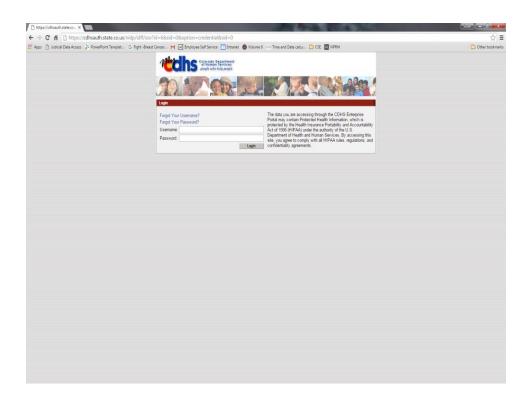
Enforcing County Rule (Volume 6.205 through 6.205.2)

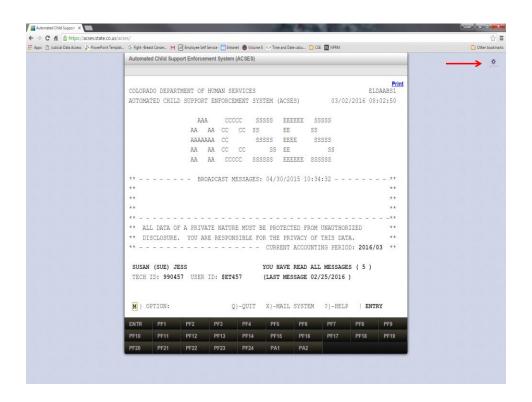

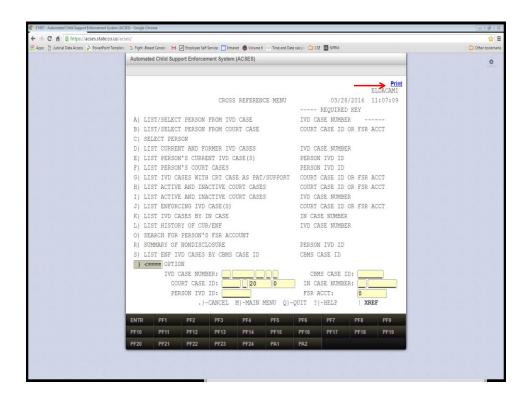


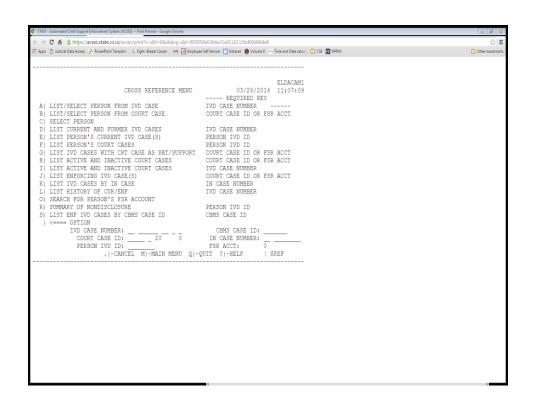




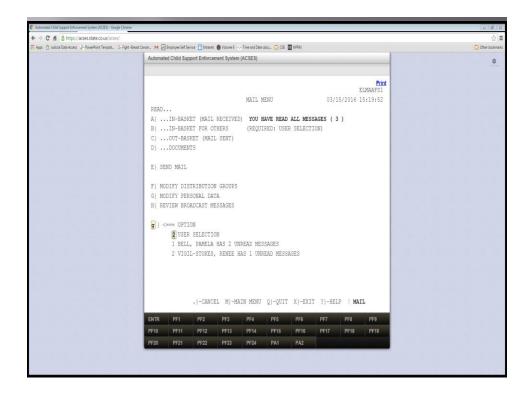


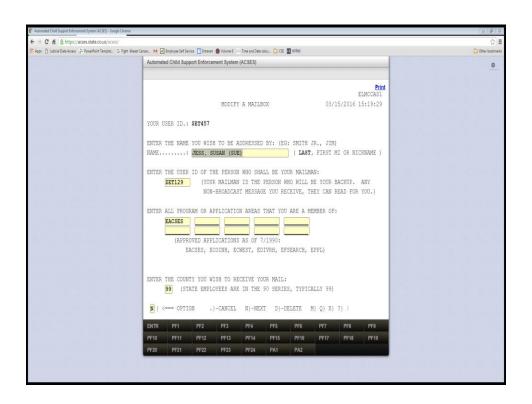


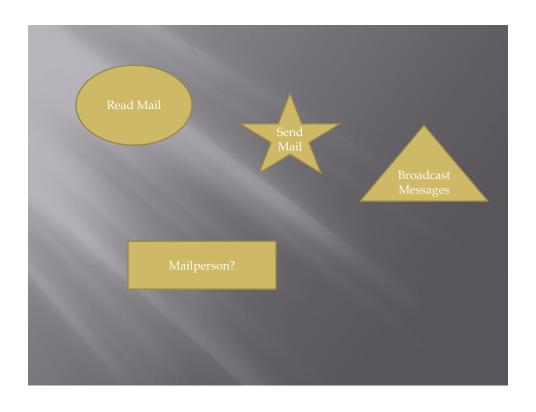
















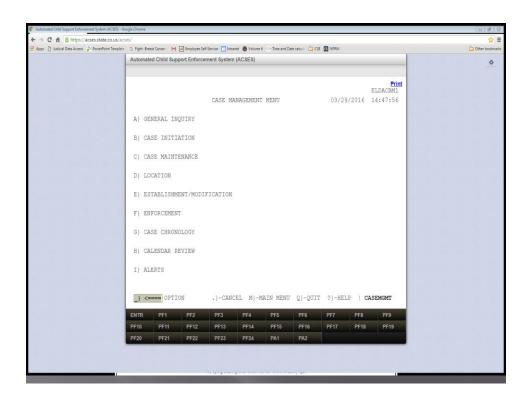
Globals

ACSES will store information behind the scenes that will allow you to move from screen to screen in one case without having to re-enter IVD case number, ledger ID, etc.

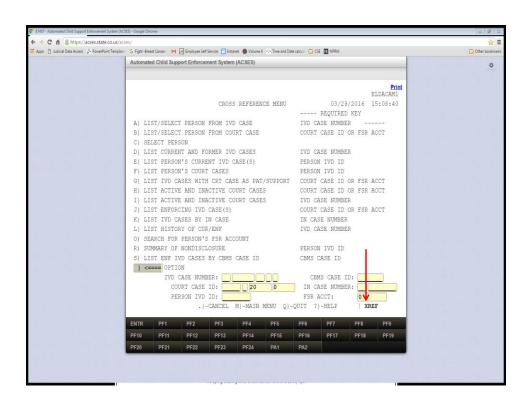




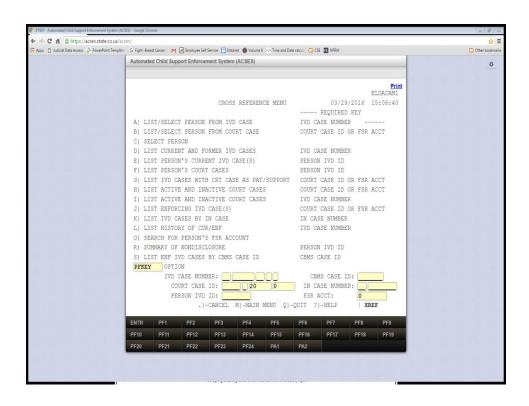


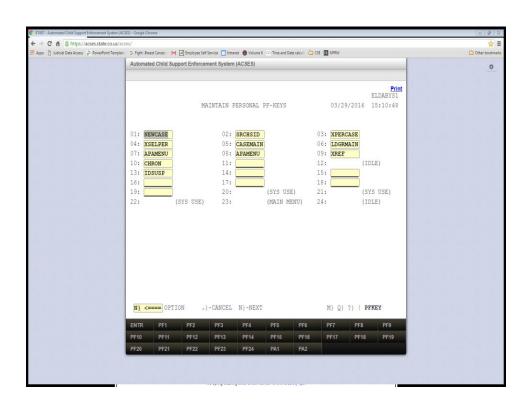


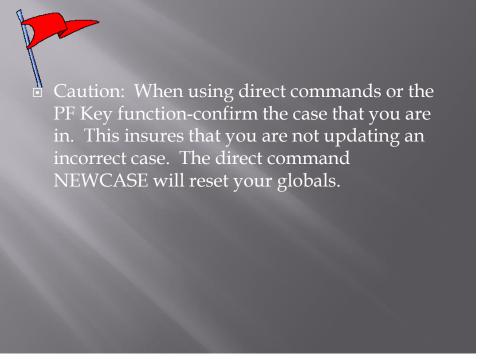












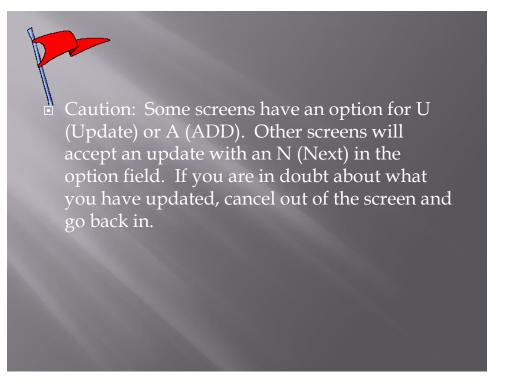
New Case

- Use this direct command when you are finished with one case and before you go into the next
- This direct command will clear your globals of all the stored information from the case you were in so globals can be stored for the next case



Standard Options

- Can cancel out of any screen by typing in a "P" in the option field, or a "." P will navigate you the previous screen, a "." will navigate you to the last menu
- ✓ A "?" in a field will pull up most code tables
- ✓ M will navigate you to the Main Menu
- Most screens have options at the bottom of the screen





Error/Warnings/Informational

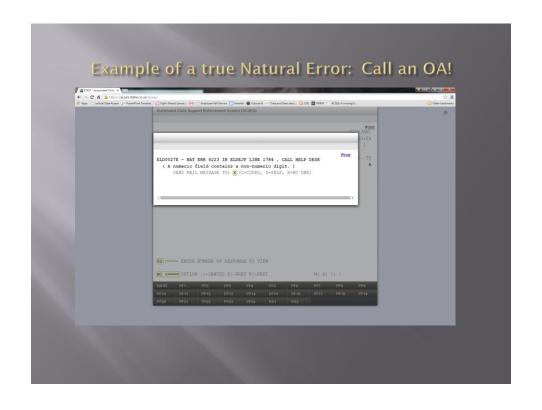
- E-Error: Must be cleared before proceeding
- W-Warning: Must be acknowledged, take appropriate action, or enter "W" in option field to continue
- I-Information: Date accepted, no action is necessary to proceed.

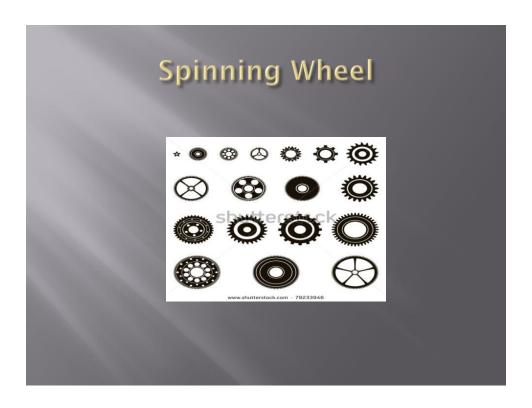
**Type in the E,W, or I, number in the option field to pull up the full message text.

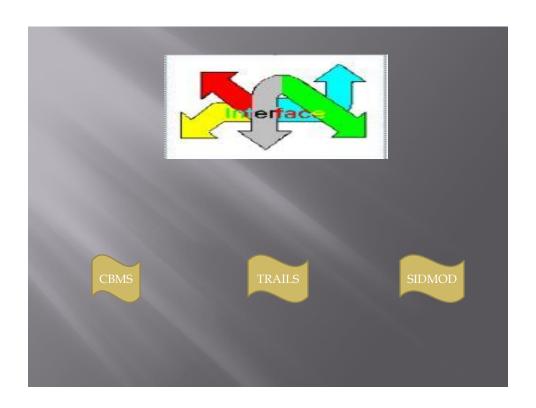


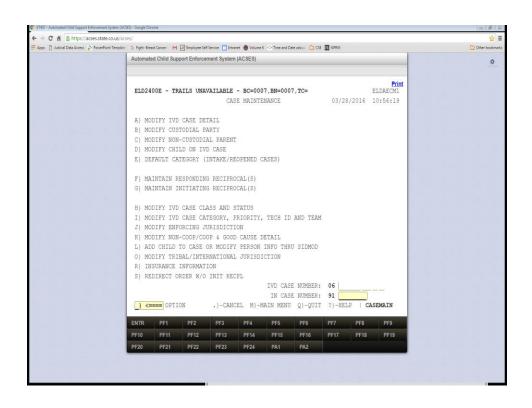

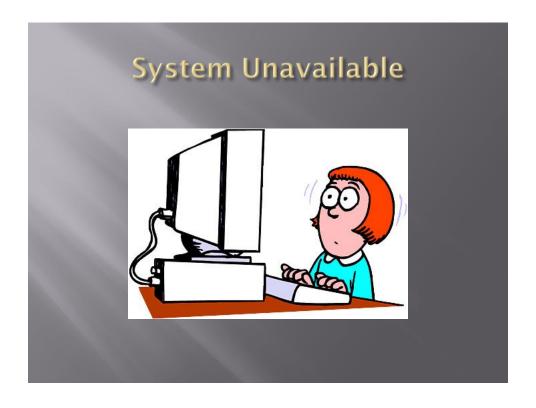
Natural Errors ELD0027E - NAT ERR ___ IN ELD__ LINE __ CALL HELP DESK DO NOT CALL THE IT SERVICE DESK Most of the time, a natural error can be resolved by clearing your globals (direct command newcase in any option field) and then trying your action again. You may need to give it 15-20 minutes and then try again. Globals are populated when you go into a case with case specific information that allows you to navigate the system without having to re-enter the case number, etc. If you are going in and out of different cases without clearing your globals before going into a new case, the globals from a prior case may carry over. We recommend clearing globals before going into a new case to avoid natural errors.



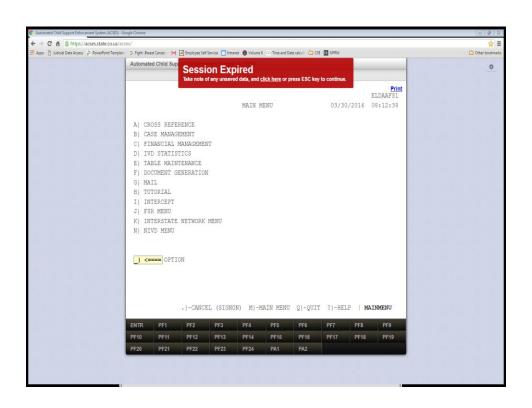






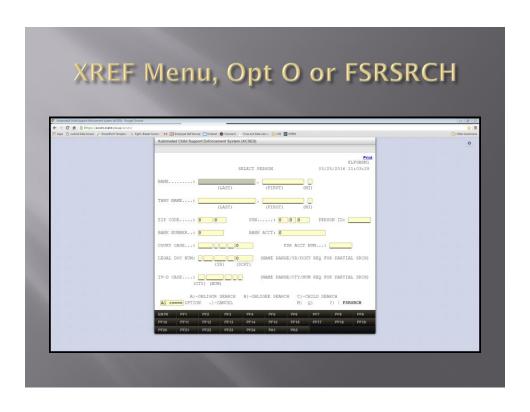




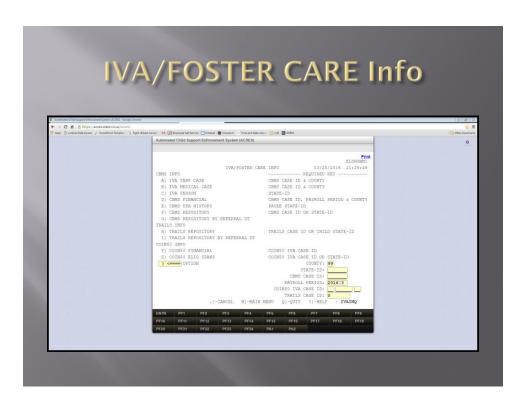


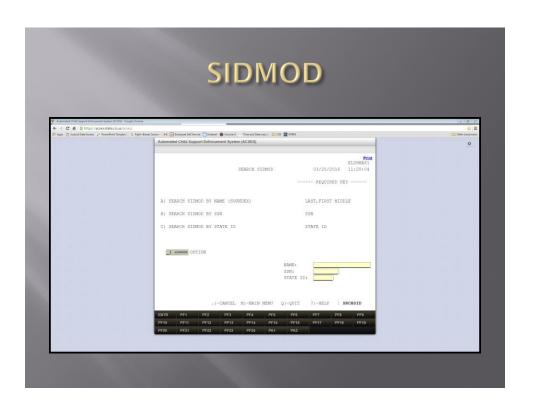




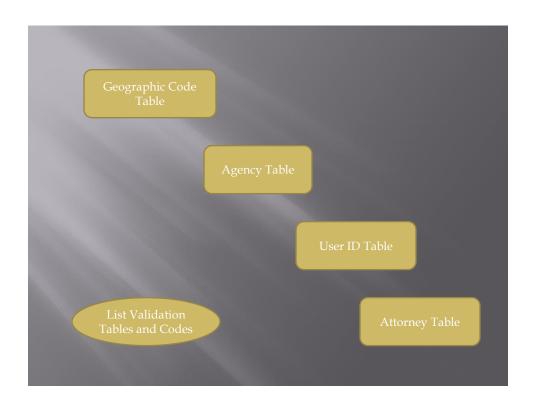










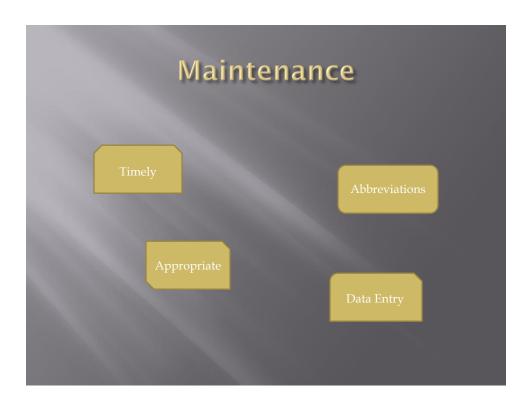


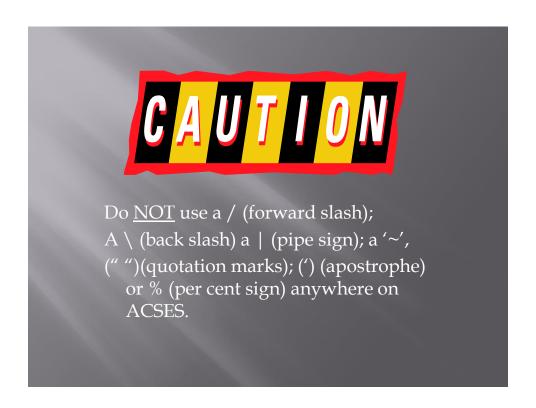
